The 2024 tasting year for the King George Wine Society got underway Jan 12 with 27members gathered to hear the Battle of the Sexes presented by the Stutlers. Board member Chris kicked off the meeting requesting members to consider presenting to which Rita agreed to bring



Wines of Turkey to us for the February meeting. The Stutlers then got underway sharing a Myth that during wine production women were not allowed in the cellars otherwise while wine is fermenting, they would "turn the wine". That has been debunked! One-half of South African winemakers are female and there exists a high number of women

winemakers in several other countries as shown by the numbers shared with us. The intent of the evening was to rate wines produced by men and women to determine if one gender was more suited to producing quality wines. Three rounds with two wines each having nearly the same grape variety were conducted. We started with Valpolicella from the Valley of Many Cellars, Veneto, IT, followed by Cotes du Rhone, FR Grenache and ending with Zinfandel from Mendocino, CA. Prices of the wines were identical to eliminate influences by cost. Of interest, both IT wines were produced from wine makers whose winery has been in the family for





generations. The French wine titles had meanings, Handful of Grapes and It's Thirsty Weather and the Zinfandels, not surprising, had over 14% alcohol. While there wasn't much discussion during the tastings, people did comment

a few times, mostly after learning which wine maker had the most votes. Results suggest female winemakers do a pretty good job making wine.
